2. **Expanding Membership:** The Committee will review membership rosters and devise strategies and actions to enhance membership and engagement among DIOs, and other educational leaders as defined by the Committee and the Executive Committee. The Committee will engage with other relevant organizations to increase membership.
1. **Other Actions:** The Committee will carry out different actions, as needed, in the interest of the membership and the organization as defined by the Executive Committee.
