



NADIO Research and Survey Committee

The NADIO Research and Survey Committee is charged with establishing an organizational framework that will promote NADIO (and its individual members) conduct of research projects that will contribute knowledge to NADIO or to the institutional domain of graduate medical education. The committee will both develop surveys that support NADIO's mission, as well as review surveys submitted by members prior to their distribution to NADIO members. The Committee's oversight of proposed surveys is necessary to respect NADIO members' time constraints, promote efficient data collection, ensure that the issues being surveyed are important for DIOs, and ensure that the survey is of high quality.

Core Responsibilities:

1. Propose to the Executive Committee research projects that may be conducted by or on behalf of NADIO
2. Review research proposals submitted by NADIO members or other organizations for projects that are suggested to be conducted by or on behalf of NADIO and submit such proposals for review of the Executive Committee
3. Development of surveys to meet specific aims defined by the Executive Committee
4. Review of surveys submitted by members to identify for distribution of well-designed surveys that prioritize issues relevant and important to the DIO community and submit such proposals for review of the Executive Committee.
